Marriage: What Happened?

Common Questions about the Marriage Amendment

What is the Marriage Protection Amendment?

The North Carolina Marriage Protection Amendment would put our State's historic definition of marriage into the Constitution where it will be protected from being altered or overturned by legislators or activist judges, as has occurred in other states.

Why is it necessary to enact the amendment now?

As recently as October 2011, same-sex couples demanded marriage licenses in Asheville, setting up a potential legal challenge to North Carolina's laws defining marriage as the union of one man and one woman. In December 2011, a lawsuit was filed challenging our state's marriage laws on state constitutional grounds. By securing marriage as the union of one man and one woman in our state constitution, challenges such as this lawsuit will not be possible. Additionally, without the amendment, any same-sex couples "married" elsewhere could move to North Carolina and sue to have their "marriage" recognized by the State of North Carolina.

NORTH CAROLINA MARRIAGE AMMENDMENT PROTECTION LANGUAGE

"Marriage between one man and one woman is the only domestic legal union that shall be valid or recognized in this State. This section does not prohibit a private party from entering into contracts with another private party; nor does this section prohibit courts from adjudicating the rights of private parties pursuant to such contracts."
