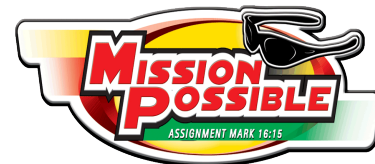


A NOTE FROM MRS. EVETTE: I made a commitment to read the Bible through in 2018. I've been using the Bible Project app on my phone. At the beginning of each section, there is an informative animated video explaining the passages. (Check it out!)



So I began in Genesis and just finished Deuteronomy. It has not been the easiest reading, and I have read a lot of it over and over trying to absorb it. I read about the big exit from Egypt where God parted the Red Sea and provided a way for the Israelites, His chosen people, to flee from slavery and the evil Pharaoh. As I continued reading through the next few books, one thing I noticed is how many times the exit was referred to. Moses reminded the Israelites how God delivered them, and how He saved and provided for them. Over and over again, generations are reminded of how God moved.

As parents, we are to continually tell our children the stories of how God moves. Not only the Bible stories of old, but the stories of how God is moving today, in our lives, in our jobs, and in our churches. We must keep God alive in our homes. He is not the God of the past, He is the God of today, and we must live like He is!
